What Are Rahu and Ketu?

Rahu (North Node): Your Future Path

Rahu shows where your soul is meant to grow in this lifetime. It represents qualities and lessons that feel new, challenging, and sometimes uncomfortable. But leaning into your North Node helps you unlock your full potential.

Think of it like learning something brand new. It can feel scary or uncomfortable at first, but it leaves you feeling inspired and opens you up to new possibilities in your life.

Ketu (South Node): Your Comfort Zone

Ketu represents your past: habits, talents, and comfort zones you've mastered in past lives (or earlier in this one). While these traits feel easy and familiar, staying stuck here can prevent growth.

Think of it like a cozy blanket: It's comfortable and sometimes you just want to snuggle up here and close out the world, but it won't inspire you to explore and grow.

Finding Balance

The goal isn't to abandon your Ketu traits entirely or only move toward your Rahu. Instead, it's about integrating both sides of self, coming into the center. The key is to embrace your strengths from the past while courageously stepping into and embracing new parts of yourself and a brighter future.

How to Find Your Rahu and Ketu in Your Chart

Step 1: Use an Astrology Chart Calculator

To find your Rahu and Ketu, you'll need a copy of your birth chart. You can pull up your chart on <u>RisingWoman.com/astrology-chart</u> OR <u>Astro.com</u>

Step 2: Input Your Birth Details

Enter your:

- Date of birth
- Time of birth (accurate time is crucial!)
- Place of birth

Step 3: Locate the Nodes

Look for the symbols in your chart:

Rahu (North Node): Retu (South Node):

Each of these symbols will be located in a specific zodiac sign and house (opposite each other) in your astrology chart.

Understanding Your Soul's Journey

Once you've found the location of your Rahu and Ketu in your chart, here's how to create your blueprint, step-by-step:

Step 1: Find the House each node is located in:

Your chart is divided into 12 areas (houses), each representing a different part of life:

- 1st House: Self & identity
- 2nd House: Money & values
- 3rd House: Communication & learning
- ...and so on.

Your Rahu & Ketu will be in different houses, opposite each other. The theme of each house indicates the area of life you need to grow into and the area you need to move away from (ultimately finding balance between the 2 areas.

Step 2: Find the Sign each node is located in

The zodiac sign that your Rahu and Ketu are in adds another layer of meaning. It describes the qualities and energy you need to embrace (north node) and what to let go of (south node).

For example:

- North Node in Aries: Learn to be bold and independent.
- South Node in Aries: Focus less on yourself and learn to rely on others.
- North Node in Libra: Focus on relationships and harmony.
- South Node in Libra: Learn to let go of overfocus on relationships and others, codependency.

Step 3: Planets in Conjunction: Extra Focus

If a planet is close to your North or South Node, it adds an extra flavor to that area. For example:

- Mercury conjunct North Node: Growth through communication and learning.
- Venus conjunct South Node: Past-life gifts in love or creativity.

4. Stack the Layers

Combine the house, sign, and any nearby planets to create a full story. For example:

• North Node in Taurus, 2nd House, conjunct Mercury: Your growth involves mastering communication to build financial stability and self-worth.

House Axes

Each Rahu / Ketu axis spans two opposite houses, highlighting tension and growth needed between different life areas. Below is a breakdown of the six key axes, showing how they work together and evolve through their themes.

1st and 7th House Axis: Self vs. Relationships

North Node in the 1st / South Node in the 7th:

Growth comes from developing independence and focusing on personal goals. Life challenges you to prioritize your identity and self-expression while moving away from over-reliance on partnerships.

North Node in the 7th / South Node in the 1st:

Your soul's journey involves cultivating deep, meaningful relationships and balancing your needs with others. Letting go of hyper-independence is key.

2nd and 8th House Axis: Money, Self–Worth, and Spirituality

North Node in the 2nd / South Node in the 8th:

Growth comes from building financial security and self-esteem. Life asks you to focus on your personal values and material stability instead of leaning too much on shared resources.

North Node in the 8th / South Node in the 2nd:

Your growth involves embracing transformation, exploring the spiritual and emotional depths of life, and cultivating trust in shared resources.

3rd and 9th House Axis: Communication vs. Higher Learning

North Node in the 3rd / South Node in the 9th:

Your journey is about honing communication skills, engaging with your immediate environment, and developing practical knowledge. Moving away from rigid beliefs or over-reliance on higher education is part of your evolution.

North Node in the 9th / South Node in the 3rd:

Life calls you to broaden your horizons through travel, philosophy, and spiritual pursuits, moving beyond small-scale thinking or local routines.

4th and 10th House Axis: Home vs. Career

North Node in the 4th / South Node in the 10th:

Growth comes from creating a stable, nurturing home environment. Letting go of over-identification with public success or career recognition is key.

North Node in the 10th / South Node in the 4th:

Your soul's path involves building a fulfilling career, contributing to the world in a visible way, and letting go of excessive attachment to comfort, home, or familial obligations.

5th and 11th House Axis: Creativity vs. Community

North Node in the 5th / South Node in the 11th:

Your focus is on personal creativity, self-expression, and embracing joy for its own sake. Letting go of excessive dependence on group dynamics or social approval will help you thrive.

North Node in the 11th / South Node in the 5th:

You're meant to share your gifts with the wider world through networks, social causes, or collaborative efforts. Moving beyond a purely self-focused creative life is part of your journey.

6th and 12th House Axis: Daily Life vs. Spiritual Exploration

North Node in the 6th / South Node in the 12th:

North Node in the 12th / South Node in the 6th:

Life calls you toward spiritual exploration, introspection, and rest. Letting go of an overemphasis on work or the material grind is part of your soul's evolution.

North Node (Rahu) and South Node (Ketu) in the Signs

Aries (North Node) / Libra (South Node)

Mercury Conjunct Node

- South Node: Past-life expertise in thinking, teaching, or storytelling.

Venus Conjunct Node

- North Node: Growth in love, relationships, and creative expression.
- South Node: Past-life gifts in beauty, art, or harmony.

Mars Conjunct Node

- North Node: Growth through taking bold action and pursuing passions.
- South Node: Past-life focus on assertiveness or aggression.

Jupiter Conjunct Node

- North Node: Expansion through wisdom, travel, or spiritual growth.
- South Node: Past-life gifts in teaching, abundance, or leadership.

Saturn Conjunct Node

- North Node: Growth through responsibility, discipline, and mastering challenges.
- South Node: Past-life focus on structure, control, or fear-based limitations.

Uranus Conjunct Node

- North Node: Growth through innovation, independence, and embracing change.
- South Node: Past-life tendencies of rebellion or unconventional behavior.

Neptune Conjunct Node

- North Node: Growth in spirituality, intuition, and creative imagination.
- South Node: Past-life immersion in fantasy, escapism, or spiritual practices.

Pluto Conjunct Node

- North Node: Growth through transformation, power, and uncovering hidden truths.
- South Node: Past-life experiences of intensity, control, or deep healing.

Chiron Conjunct Node

- North Node: Growth through healing wounds and teaching others.
- South Node: Past-life experiences with pain, healing, or mentorship.

Ascendant Conjunct Node

- North Node: Growth in personal identity and self-presentation.
- South Node: Past-life attachment to how you were perceived by others.

Midheaven (MC) Conjunct Node

- North Node: Growth through career, public image, and life direction.
- South Node: Past-life tendencies of focusing on societal roles or achievements.
